

CHEA intends to award a \$1,000 scholarship each year to one graduating home educated student who is continuing education at a college, university, or accredited career or vocational school.

Please review this instruction sheet and Application Form Cover Sheet carefully so you understand the requirements.

Applications must be submitted to CHEA no later than February 28. The Scholarship Application Cover Sheet and all attachments must be typed. No handwritten applications will be accepted.

Applications not submitted in proper order or by the deadline will be automatically disqualified. To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet *all* of the following criteria:

Student Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must have been privately homeschooled (not enrolled in a public school program), with their parents teaching them at home at least 51% of the time and at least 51% of the academic subjects, for at least the last four years.*
- 2. Applicants must be at least 16 by December 1 and no older than 19 on June 30.
- 3. Applicants' parents must have been CHEA Members at least since August 1, 2024 and maintain their membership through July 31, 2026.
- 4. Applicants must be accepted for admission to a college (including community college), university, or accredited career/vocational school the following August/September of the next school year.
- 5. Applicants must be able to attend the Saturday morning Opening Session of the Annual Convention, if selected to receive the Scholarship. CHEA will provide for transportation and one night's housing for the scholarship winner and one parent if he or she lives more than 100 miles from the Convention site.

*For the purposes of this scholarship, the student must have been taught at home by his/her parents at least 51% of the time and at least 51% of the academic subjects to be considered homeschooled. Courses taken other places, i.e. college courses taken during high school, co-op courses, etc., should be noted.

Employees and staff of CHEA, Board of Directors, Regional Advisory Board Members, or their immediate families are not eligible for the scholarship.

Application Requirements Continued

All application requirements should be compiled and submitted to CHEA by the applicant in one email. Applications must be submitted to scholarship@cheaofca.org by 11:59 p.m. on February 28, 2025. Please contact us at scholarship@cheaofca.org or by phone at 562-864-2432 if an alternate submission method is necessary.

Applicants will be notified by email of the scholarship results by the first week of May. **No funds will** be issued to the student. The scholarship award will be sent directly to the college to be applied to the student's tuition or curriculum costs. In the event the student does not attend the college in the fall term, he must notify CHEA no later than September 1 indicating the reason for the delay. CHEA will hold the scholarship funds until the spring term. Otherwise, the scholarship will be forfeited.
